The Knight Club (TKC) provides an opportunity for students in grades K-9 to complete their homework with the assistance of a teacher. Aside from offering academic support, **The Knight Club** balances down time with structured enrichment activities. Snack is provided each day and students are offered time outside whenever the weather allows.

### Hours

Monday – Friday 3:00pm – 6:00pm  
*\*A late fee of \$17 every 15 minutes will be charged after 6:00pm.*

### Fees

#### **Registered Students**

\$12.00 per day (or)  
\$55.00 per week (\$5 discount)

***\*Families will be billed monthly for the days signed up for regardless of any absences (including but not limited to: sports, vacation, illness).***

#### **Non-Registered Students (Drop-In)**

\$17.00 per day

To ensure available staffing, students will only be allowed to drop-in on a daily basis after the parent has obtained permission by contacting the front office or the Knight Club Director at (336) 235-4659. The drop-in rate is \$17.00 per day, regardless of check-in/check-out time.

**Students who are not picked up by 3:15pm will be required to report to The Knight Club, and parents will be charged the drop-in rate.**

Families who are consistently late to pick up their children and do not pay for the necessary supervision, risk dismissal from The Knight Club.

**This form must be completed and returned to the office even if you choose not to register your child.**

### Expectations

1. Students will adhere to Noble Academy's Expectations and Rules of Conduct. Repeated violations will result in dismissal from the program.
2. Homework is a priority and will be completed before enrichment activities. Students will ask the teacher to check off assignments in their assignment book.
3. Drivers will sign out their riders inside the building when leaving.
4. Absences will not reduce the cost.
5. Written notice to the Community Programs is required two weeks in advance of withdrawing. If a student arbitrarily stops attending, charges will continue to accrue until 2 weeks after written notice of withdrawal is received.
6. Inclement weather closings will be announced on *WFMY News 2*, our phone message, and our website.
7. Families will be billed monthly. If payment is not received in a timely manner, dismissal from the program may result.
