An Overview



Happy Summer Noble Families!

The Noble High School English Department is **thrilled** to teach your child next year and, with that in mind, we have created a **plan for summer reading to prep the kids for the upcoming school year.**

We will send home a physical flier and a blank template for our summer reading assignment, something we have called the "One-Pager." Essentially, your child will be **completing these tasks:**

1. **Read a book** of their choice. Teachers and students will select these together before the end of this school year and parents will be sent the information.
2. **Complete the digital portion of the one pager/analysis questions** in the Google Classroom (see assignments #001-#004).
 - When the time comes, your child will be added to the Summer Reading Google Classroom. They will complete a few tasks in there before moving on to the one-pager assignment.
3. **Complete the physical copy of the one-pager** (in the summer packets sent home).

If at any point you **lose your physical copy** of the one-pager template, we have printed copies at the Noble front desk that you can pick up or there is a digital copy that students can print from home. We ask that students do not do digital art or virtual illustration for this--it needs to be completed by hand.

By way of preparing for the assignment, your child will need **access to a digital or print version of the book they chose and any art supplies** (colored pencils, markers, regular pencils etc.) they want to use for the physical copy of their one-pager. Color is not required for this, however, detail is.

If you need more explanation for how the project works, you can **scan** the QR code to the right OR find any information you need (along with high-scoring examples of one pagers from past students) in the **Google Classroom** once access is given.
